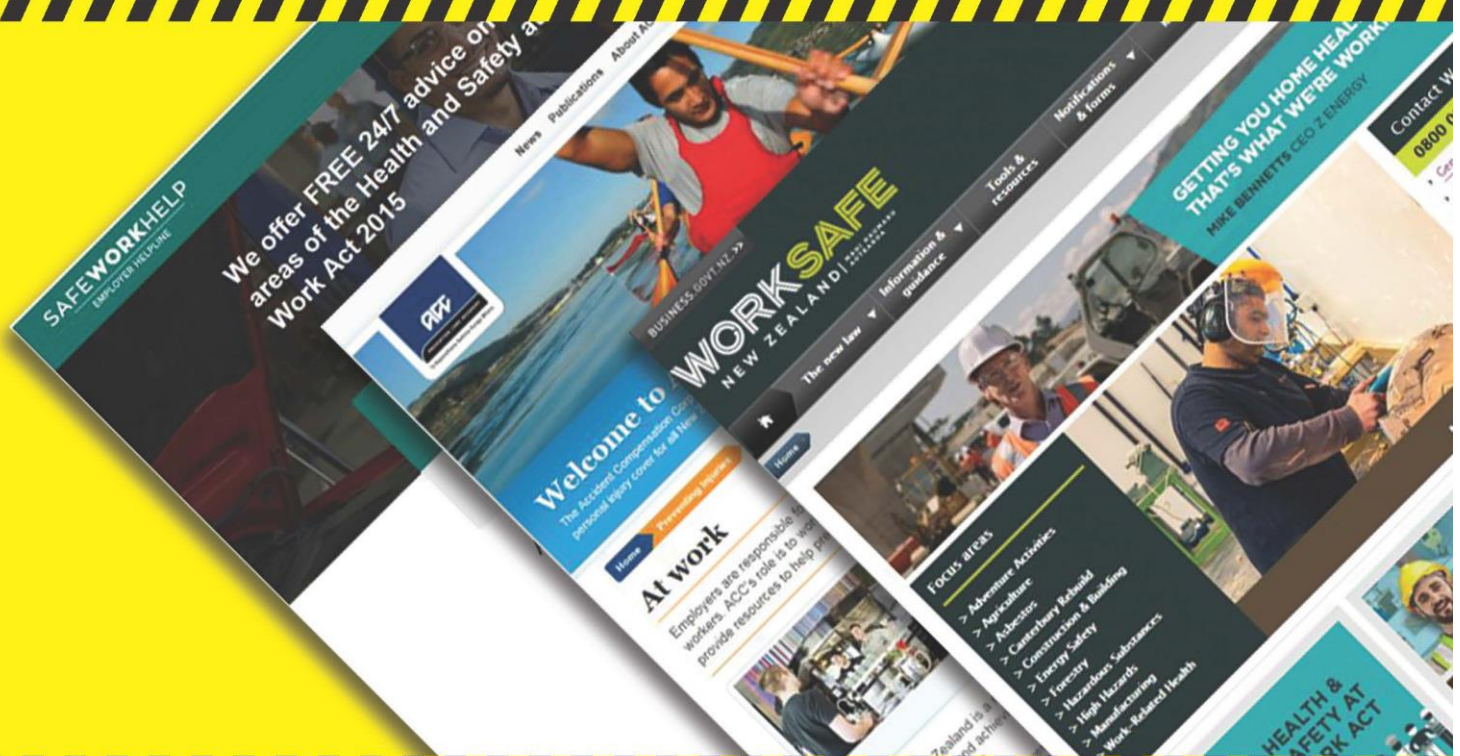

MANAGING HAZARDS IN THE WORKPLACE!

As an employer, you now have a duty to eliminate, or minimise hazards to your employees. Moving equipment and vehicles in manufacturing and storage sites can be fatal if not used correctly and safely. Known as mobile plant these hazards have the potential to cause serious injury or kill someone due to striking them with vehicles or equipment. The most common examples being forklifts, delivery trucks and other light vehicles.

What the Act Stipulates:











A person conducting a business or undertaking has a duty to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, workers and others are not exposed to health and safety risks arising from the business or undertaking. This duty includes implementing control measures to prevent people being injured by moving vehicles at the workplace.

Key areas to review when managing traffic in warehouses:

- Pedestrian safety, well-marked road/ pedestrian areas, safe and shared areas marked
- Designated loading/unloading areas, improved forklift traction, one way systems
- The layout of the work pedestrian with designated crossing points, hazard identification points
- Using powered load shifting equipment, speed management, separate entrances for plant/people
- Developing and implementing a traffic management plan.
- Signage, warning devices and visibility
